Strengthening collaboration to accelerate progress for achieving universal access to water, sanitation and hygiene.

# The main objectives of the conference are:

- 2. Strengthen water, sanitation and hygiene sector coordination and collaboration towards identification of gaps, harmonization of approaches, and cementing of partnerships and sector financing.




